

Wholesale Gas Price 2000-2013


Wholesale Gas Price 2000 – 2013 (day ahead gas prices (p/therm))

Average Weekly Household Expenditure on Fuel, Light and Power as a % of all Goods (including housing costs)






Average Share of Gas and Electricity in Weekly Household Spend (Excluding Housing Costs) by Income Deciles, %



Average Weekly Household Expenditure on Fuel, Light and Power as a % of all Goods (including housing costs)






Customer Complaints 2008-2013
